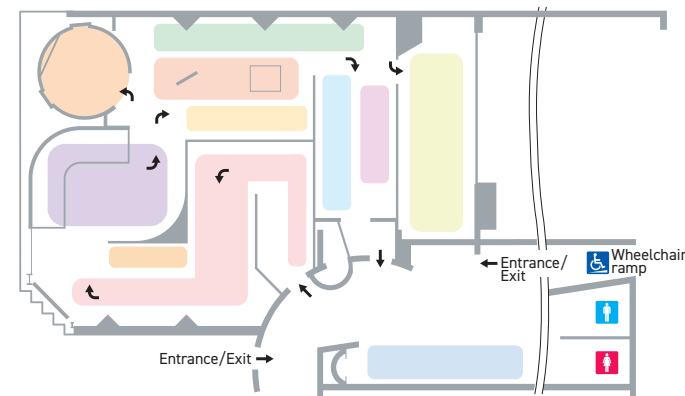




Hakone Ekiden Museum

| | ○Take the bus from Odawara Station on the JR or Odakyu lines for about 50 minutes and get off at Hakonemachiko (Hakone-machi Port). |
| By car | ○Approximately 55 minutes from Atsugi IC on the Tomei Expressway, approximately 55 minutes from Gotemba IC. |

- Guests with pets are not allowed inside the venue. (Guide dogs and service dogs are excluded.)

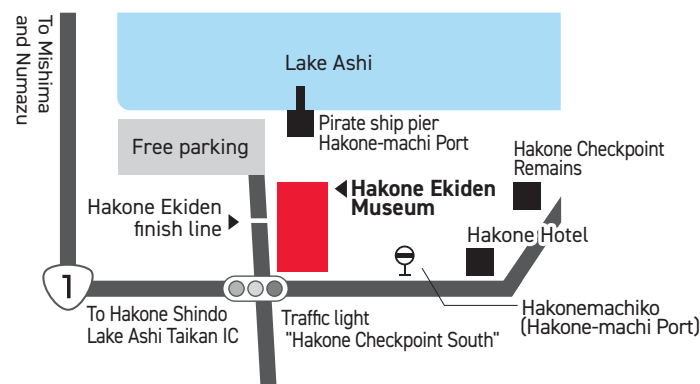
